Late Summer Tennis Tournament

Play to begin the week of August 2nd through August 8th

Men's & Women's Brackets

Doubles & Singles

Two divisions: 2.5 to 3.0 and 3.5 to 4.0

RULES: The first player or team to win 4 points wins the game. At 3 points to 3 points the receiver of serve decides whether service goes to the deuce or ad court. The winner of this point wins the game. First to 6 games by 2, wins the set. At 6 games to 6 games, a 7 point tie breaker is played to decide the set. A tie breaker must be decided by 2 points or more. Best of three sets wins the match.

Everyone will get to play at least twice, as players losing their first match will drop into a consolation bracket and continue until a second loss occurs.

Each player will play at least one match per entry each week. Once your opponent for your next match is known, you may contact one another and proceed when both players or teams are ready to play. You do not necessarily need to wait until the next week begins to play subsequent matches. It is not imperative that you play at FTFRC.

After brackets are drawn, everyone will be notified as to whom their first opponent will be. Opponents will be given one another's contact information. Each player will be responsible for arranging his/her matches each week. The winner will then email results to Bob Zeiger at: dabigz@aol.com. You will then be notified whom you will play next. Also, brackets and results, etc. will be posted in the clubhouse at FTFRC. Once again, you will need to contact opponents, play your matches and report your results. This will continue until winners are decided in the championship and consolation brackets.

Each player/team is to bring a new can of ball to every match. The winner keeps the new can to take to the next match. The loser keeps the used balls.
